- Engage in evidence informed practices and research to inform your teaching.

- Master's degree in Acupuncture and Traditional Chinese Herbal Medicine or Master's degree in field of study (e.g., MSW, MN).
- Texas L. Ac. and 5 years professional clinical experience for clinical supervision and professional clinic practice.
- Background in didactic and/or clinic instruction. Strong communication, writing, interpersonal, and conflict management skills
- Possesses a good attitude, strong work ethic, and an eagerness to learn

- Proficient in basic computer skills and software (Microsoft suite, Word, Outlook, Google browsing, and Zoom).
- Proficient with learning management tools, such as Brightspace, Canvas, Blackboard, Moodle, CAMS, Populi, etc.
